1	<p>Filing of a Spirit of Illinois proposal by September 15th 2010 with the District Deputy indicating your council's action plan of programming for the fraternal year 2010-2011</p> <p>Recognition for councils is based upon the level of membership, program, and charities participation</p> <p>Gold Medal Level – Outstanding Council [minimum 38-44 programs] Must host two 1st Degrees one between July 1st and December 31st AND one between January 1st and June 30th</p> <p>Silver Medal Level - Outstanding Council [minimum of 33-37 programs]</p> <p>Bronze Medal Level - Outstanding Council [minimum of 26-32 programs]</p> <p>Honorable Mention – Outstanding Council [minimum of 18 programs]</p>
2	<p>Supreme Council Forms Filed: 185 - Report of Council Officers filed by July 1 365 - Service Program Personal filed by August 1 1728 - Fraternal Activities filed by January 15 1295 - Semi-Annual Audit Reports filed by August 15 & February 15</p>
3	<p>State Per-capita payment by due date to the Illinois State Council</p>
4	<p>Obtain at least 4 new Members between July 1st to December 31st 2010 and 3 new members between January 1st to June 30th 2011</p>
5	<p>Obtain 1 new member during each of the 5 membership blitz periods: July 15 – Aug 15, 2010 October 2010 (Columbus Day) December 1, 2010 – January 15, 2011 March 2011 (Founders Day) June 1 – June 26, 2011</p>
6	<p>Participate in all five (5) charitable activities and achieve at least three (3) of the council goals in the following areas: Vocations, Intellectual Disabilities, Newman, General Assistance Fund, Pro-Life</p>
7	<p>Obtain positive membership numbers as of June 30, 2011</p>
8	<p>COUNCIL completes tally sheet and has the District Deputy verify completion of programs. June 30, 2011 is deadline for filing of Tally Sheet; some programs may be completed after the deadline if approved by the District Deputy</p>
	<p>The District Deputy should meet with the Council Grand Knight and General Program Director by September 15th 2010 to plan the programming for the upcoming fraternal year.
